- Full concierge to arrange trips and tours for entertainment

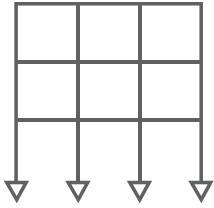
Cost

290 euros per person per 24 hours assuming eight delegates attending.
150 euros per person over eight, sharing rooms.

The chateau accommodates up to 16 adults in 8 large double rooms ensuite with super king sized beds.

Fly from the UK to Bergerac with Ryanair, Flybe, BMI Baby,
or to Bordeaux with Easyjet, British Airways, BMI Baby, Flybe or Air France
The chateau is 50 minutes from either airport

Train from Paris Montparnasse to Libourne, direct service three hours twenty minutes, twice a day.
Libourne is a twenty minute drive from the chateau



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Nannies

The house is particularly child friendly and we welcome children within the retreat. Nannies are available at a cost of 25 euros per hour and children's lunch and supper

Suggested three night plan

Day one

Arrive at Rigaud in the afternoon

Afternoon tea upon arrival and chateau tour

Canapés and cocktails in the bar at 8pm followed by a rustic and informal dinner

Day two

Assuming a full day of meetings and work

Breakfast and lunch at the chateau with tea and coffee breaks provided as per the required working schedule

Tutored Wine Tasting Dinner with Bordeaux Wine Expert Alex Hall. Can be as cheap or as expensive as you want it to be with the tutor's fee of 350 euros plus a wine budget from 80 euros to the sky. 200 euros to spend on wine makes for a very interesting night. Can be seriously informative and educational or with a lighter, or competitive feel.

Day three

Further meetings and work schedule in the morning with lunch at Rigaud followed by an afternoon in the vines...

Lunch with Fabian Barnes, wine writer and oenologist, at a typical French workman's "Relais" style restaurant

Spend the afternoon with Fabain and "Discover the world of the Bio Dynamic Vignaron - Sing the song of love to the Ladybirds in the vines"

Formal dinner at Rigaud or at the local restaurant La Poudette, in which case Rigaud will provide canapés and cocktails pre dinner and a taxi service to and from the restaurant.
